## **PRISMAVISIONS**

The Prisma Visions series explores the interplay of light, reflection, and perception. The color-shifting mirrors with dichroic effects create a dynamic visual experience that changes depending on the viewing angle.

The works are composed of high-gloss polished, color-shifting mirrors and come in two categories: Mono (a single triangular shape) and Duo (two triangular shapes).


Due to the use of dichroic materials, the colors oscillate instead of appearing static.

A key aesthetic feature lies in the paradox of reflection: while traditional mirrors return the viewer's image, these artworks deny direct self-observation. The fragmented and distorted reflections refuse to present a complete image of the self; the viewer's likeness remains elusive. This creates a subtle disorientation that plays with the deconstruction of the self and the materiality of light.

PrismaVisions aligns with the tradition of geometric-abstract art movements, particularly Op Art and kinetic art, in which optical phenomena and perceptual illusions play a central role.
